NOTIFICATION

Port Blair, dated the 20th September, 2017.

No. 227/2017/ F.No.4-1/2017-PWD.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi Notification No.U-14039/2/83-ANL dated 21st February, 1985 and the UPSC's letter No.3/30(4)/2015-RR dated 28.07.2017 and also in supersession of all earlier Notifications on the subject matter, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **Assistant Engineer (Electrical & Mechanical)** in the Andaman Public Works Department, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:-

- These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration Assistant Engineer (E&M) in Andaman Public Works Department Recruitment Rules, 2017.
- They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix:-

The number of said posts, its classification and Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in paras 2, 3 & 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications:-

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to said posts shall be as specified in paras 5 to 13 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

4. Disqualification:-

No person,

- who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living;

OR

- who, having spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person(s) shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law, applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage or there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

5. Power to relax:-

Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with UPSC, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings:-

Nothing in these rules shall effect reservations, relaxation in age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

SCHEDULE**RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT ENGINEER (ELECTRICAL & MECHANICAL IN ANDAMAN PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT**

11. In case of recruitment by promotion/ deputation / absorption, grades from which promotion / deputation / absorption to be made.

PROMOTION:

(i) 45% by Junior Engineer (E&M) in Level-6 in the Pay Matrix possessing Degree in Electrical or Mechanical Engineering from a recognized University or having passed Part A & B Examination of the Institution of Engineers (India) with 05 years regular service in the grade.

(ii) 45% by Junior Engineer (E&M) in Level-6 in the Pay Matrix possessing Diploma in Electrical or Mechanical Engineering from a recognized Institution and with 05 years regular service in the grade.

(iii) 10% by Junior Engineer (E&M) Non-Diploma with 05 years regular service in the grade and possessing two years ITI Certificate of Draughtsmanship (E&M).

TRAINING :

One week training in Administrative and Technical matters.

NOTE: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/ eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/ eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/ eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/ eligibility service.

Deputation (ISTC) :

Officers under the Central/State Governments/Union Territories/ Recognized Research Institutions/Public Sector Undertakings/ Semi-Government/ Statutory or Autonomous Organizations.

(a) (i) Holding Analogous posts on a regular basis in the Parent Cadre Department; **OR**

(ii) With five years service in the Grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in Level-6 in the Pay Matrix in the Parent Cadre / Department;

And

(b) (i) Degree in Electrical or Mechanical Engineering from a recognized University or having passed Part A & B Examination of Institution of Engineers (India).

(ii) Two years experience in the relevant field.

NOTE 1 : The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation/ absorption. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

NOTE 2 : (Period of deputation (ISTC) including period of deputation (ISTC) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization/ Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (ISTC) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications).
