NOTIFICATION

Port Blair, dated the 15th July, 2011

No. 165/2011/F.No.4-20/2010-PWD.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No. U-14039/2/83-ANL dated 21st February, 1985 and the UPSC's letter No. F. 3/30(26)/2010-RR dated 15th June, 2011 and also in supersession of all earlier Notifications on the subject matter, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **Executive Engineer (Civil)** in the Public Works Department, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:-

- (i) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration (Executive Engineer (Civil) in the establishment of APWD) Recruitment Rules, 2011.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay:-

The number of said posts, the classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be specified against paras 2, 3 & 4 of the Schedules annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications:-

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified against paras 5 to 13 of the said Schedules.

4. Disqualifications:-

No persons —

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law, applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage or there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

5. Powers to relax:-

Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and, if necessary in consultation with UPSC relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings:-

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belongs to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
