The above financial up-gradation will have no change in the designation, classification or higher status of the officials.

The officials are entitled for fixation of pay ds per provisions of CCS (RP) Rules 2016 and DoPTs guidelines on MACPs dated 19/05/2009.

The officials shall exercise their option under FR 22 (I) (a) (i) within one month from the date of issue of this order to get their pay fixed in the higher grade pay either from the date of up gradation or from the date of next increment.

No stepping up of pay is admissible with regards to junior getting more pay than the senior on account of pay fixation.

The above financial up-gradation will be withdrawn, in case it is noticed later that the financial up-gradation under MACPs given is incorrect and the excess payment made on account of the MACP will be deducted/adjusted from the future salary of the employee.
